He has worked for several social service agencies in clinical case management: Holy Family Institute, Shuman Juvenile Detention Center, Gateway Rehabilitation Center and Drug & Alcohol Counseling with the Juvenile Courts of Allegheny County.

He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology from Geneva College, a Master's degree in Professional Counseling from Liberty University and was awarded an Honorary Doctorate for Public Service from Denver Institute of Urban Studies in Colorado.

Rev. Bell has ministered at many churches around the country, as well as on radio and television. He has appeared as a speaker on Cornerstone Television "Focus 4", "Real Life" and "Ask the Pastor" programs in Pittsburgh, PA.
